## **PARK POND CLUB RULES**

## THESE RULES REPRESENT INSURANCE STIPULATED REGULATIONS

- Please limit the number of your guests at one time to 6 per membership. Members are responsible for having their guests review the Club rules.
- 2. The Park Pond Club is not set up to accommodate larger events. The Club has limited parking, only one restroom facility and no lifeguards. In order to mitigate the Club's risk, no large events are permitted.
- 3. NO Alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises.
- 4. Member's vehicle MUST display the Park Pond Club member sticker on their window and it must be visible from outside. Stickers are issued upon acceptance of membership or membership renewal. Stickers are NOT to be transferred to another person's vehicle and must match the license plate that is written on the sticker. ALL vehicles without stickers MUST park outside the gate, along the road.
- 5. Members MUST ACCOMPANY their guests at all times and are responsible for their guests. Guest vehicles must be parked outside the gate, along the road.
- 6. Members and their guests must stay within the boundaries of the club.
- 7. Entrance to the club must be made through the driveway or by man-powered boat launched from the public boat launch. (reference rule #13)
- 8. No person shall go in the water unless another person who is a capable swimmer is present.
- 9. No person shall swim beyond the roped area.
- 10. No person shall swim under the docks or floats.
- 11. Any person under the age of 16 years old shall be accompanied by a capable swimmer 16 years of age or older.
- 12. Only capable swimmers, not dog paddlers, are allowed to swim to the outside dock. Life jackets do not qualify a person as a capable swimmer.
- 13. There shall be no undue roughness, i.e., no wrestling on docks, chicken fights, sinking or rocking the docks.
- 14. Except for Coast Guard approved life jackets, NO floatation or other gear, which includes scuba, snorkels, flippers, kickboards, swimmies, balls, tubes, or inflated toys or assisted swimming devices are allowed or shall be used.
- 15. NO boats, kayaks, paddle boards, etc. shall be launched from or removed through Park Pond Club; the public boat launch is to be used. Those arriving must be beached outside the roped area. (only manpowered boats are allowed at the beach club)(reference rule #5)
- 16. The facilities shall be vacated at sundown. Please be considerate of the closing crew and be on your way out before they arrive.
- 17. There are no garbage facilities. Please take out the garbage or debris you bring in.
- 18. NO dogs are allowed on the premises.
- 19. Bicycles must be left at the bottom of the walkway down to beach, off to the left side. They cannot be brought in the beached area.

By signing the membership form, you agree that you have read and will abide by the above rules and regulations as stipulated by the insurance company.

Violation of any of the above mentioned rules may include: First offense will be a warning; Second offense could lead to termination of individual and or family membership, without a refund of membership. Updated 7/6/22
